

ORDINANCE #C2023-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VI, CHAPTER 1 OF THE GALLUP CITY CODE TO CONFER JURISDICTION UPON THE MUNICIPAL COURT TO HEAR CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS CHARGING DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED, SECOND AND THIRD OFFENSES, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Title VI, Chapter 1 of the Gallup City Code deprives the Gallup Municipal Court of jurisdiction over the charge of Driving While Intoxicated, Second or Third Offense; and

WHEREAS, the Gallup City Council desires to restore the Municipal Court's jurisdiction to hear criminal complaints alleging Driving While Intoxicated, Second or Third Offense;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALLUP, NEW MEXICO THAT:

SECTION I. Section 6-1-1 of the Gallup City Code is amended to read as follows:

6-1-1: ADOPTION OF UNIFORM TRAFFIC ORDINANCE:

The 2010 compilation of the New Mexico uniform traffic ordinance, comprising sections 12-1-1 through 12-13-6 inclusive, and any subsequent amendments made thereto and compiled therein from time to time, are herewith adopted by reference, pursuant to section 3-17-6, New Mexico Statutes Annotated, 1978.

The ordinance as adopted shall be available for inspection in the Office of the Municipal Clerk during regular and normal business hours of the Municipal Clerk. A copy of the code shall be available upon request and payment of a reasonable charge. (Ord. 2013-8, 10-22-2013)

SECTION II. Section 6-1-2 of the Gallup City Code is hereby repealed.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date of adoption.
