

ORDINANCE NO. C2023-2

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO FIREWORKS, REMOVING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR THE USE, DISCHARGE OR DETONATION OF PERMISSIBLE FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS, REPEALING TITLE 4, CHAPTER 8, SECTION 10 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF GALLUP, NEW MEXICO

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALLUP, NEW MEXICO, that:

Section 1. Sections 4-8-10A and 4-8-10B of the Gallup Municipal Code, "Permit Required for Discharge/Detonations," is hereby repealed in its entirety:

~~4-8-10: PERMIT REQUIRED FOR DISCHARGE/DETONATION:~~

~~—A. Any person or entity who desires to shoot permissible fireworks in the city limits of the city of Gallup is required to obtain a permit from the city of Gallup for the discharge/launching of fireworks. The Gallup city council shall set the costs of such permits by resolution after consultation with the Gallup fire department.~~

~~—B. Any person who detonates fireworks within the city of Gallup in violation of this section shall be fined no less than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) and no more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00). (Ord. 2013-10, 12-10-2013)~~

Section 2. Section 4-8-11 of the Gallup Municipal Code, "Use of Permissible Fireworks," shall be renumbered as Section 4-8-10:

4-8-10: USE OF PERMISSIBLE FIREWORKS:

The use of any permissible fireworks not prohibited by this chapter should be confined to areas that are paved or barren or that have a readily accessible source of water for use by the homeowner or the general public.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its passage.
